#### **Parish Assessment**

We will provide Parish Assessment forms in the month of September for you to bring to the pastor of your parish.

#### **New Student Requirements**

Once the student has been accepted to St. Mary's Schools, records from the previous school, including final report cards, final transcript, test scores, IEP (if applicable), and school health records need to be forwarded to St. Mary's Schools. A transcript release form is available in our office if your school does not supply one.

#### **Kindergarten, Fourth, Seventh and Ninth Grade Medical Forms**

It is a state law that all students entering **kindergarten, grades 4, 7 and 9** have a physical by their family physician. A printed form showing your immunizations must be returned to the office prior to or on the first day of school. For all students entering St. Mary's for the **first** time, it is **mandatory** that

their health records from the last school attended be forwarded to us prior to the first day of school or the student will not be allowed to attend classes.

### **Sports Physicals**

Any student interested in participating in the sports program must have a physical by their family physician. The form used must include the **date of exam, clearance for the student to participate in sports and must be signed by the physician.** The form must be returned before the student is allowed to practice or play in the games. **For any 7<sup>th</sup> or 9<sup>th</sup> graders: the mandatory physical form may be copied and used for the sports program.** A Physical Form and Parental Consent Form can be printed out by going to the school website and selecting athletics and see downloads for athletic forms.

### **Soccer**

Reminder: the first day of practice for students interested in playing varsity soccer is **Thursday, August, 24<sup>th</sup>** at Vernon Hill Park.

### **Volleyball**

Reminder: the first day of practice for students interested in playing girls volleyball is **Thursday, August 24<sup>th</sup>** in the school gym. ### **Uniforms/Dress Code Reminders**

Per St. Mary's uniform policy:

- **No sandals, slippers, boots (other than during winter uniform) or moccasins are allowed;**
- **No facial piercings allowed;**
- **Hair is to be of your own natural hair color.**

### **Junior/Senior High School Supply List**

### **Before School and After-School Program**

St. Mary's Schools offer a Before School Program and an After-School Program for Grades PreK-8. The Before School Program will open at **6:30 am**. A light breakfast will be served at that time. Any students in grades PreK-8 dropped off prior to 7:15 am must attend the Before School Program and will be charged a flat fee of \$5.00 per day. Any students arriving after 7:15 am will not be charged for the program. The After-School Program is open to any students in grades PreK-8. **The After-School will open at 2:15 pm and close at 5:45 pm.** A snack will be provided for students. The flat-rate for the After-School Program is \$10.00 per day. This program will also be available for students on half days for a flat fee of \$15.00 per day. All fees must be paid in advance; no student will be allowed to attend either program without payment. The policy and fees are subject to change. Please send in registration form ASAP so that we can coordinate and plan for staffing in advance.
